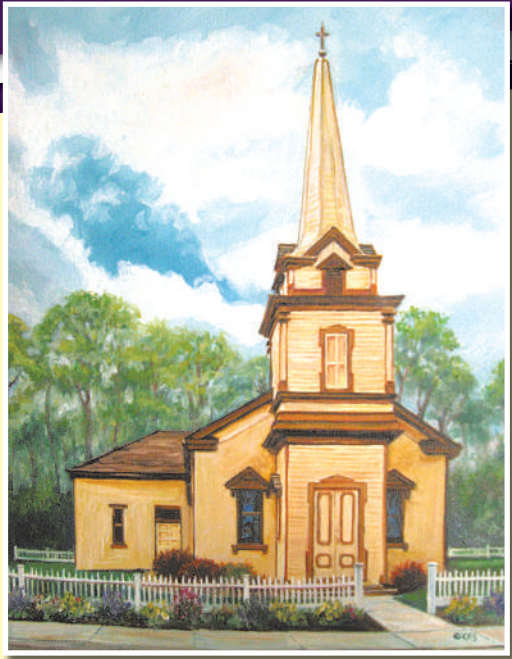


# The Olde Towne Development Committee Welcomes you to *Bellevue, Nebraska!*

- The 1830s log cabin is the oldest remaining building between the Missouri River and the Pacific Ocean erected in the United States Territory.
- The 1st Presbyterian Church is located between 19th and 20th avenues in Olde Towne. Built in 1856, it is one of several remaining buildings from this era in Bellevue.
- The Fontenelle Bank is the oldest commercial public building in Nebraska.
- The Sarpy County Museum is located at 2402 Clay Street.
- Bellevue Little Theater showcases a variety of talent for a big theatre production with a small town community feel.
- Haworth Park is 153 acres centered on the Missouri River. Features RV and tent camping, marina, playground, picnic tables and more.
